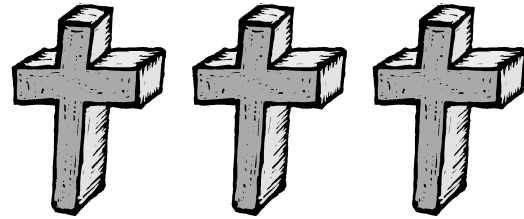

Adult Initiation into the Catholic Church/

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Any adult wishing to begin (or complete) his or her initiation into the Catholic Church are encouraged to enter into a process of faith formation (prayer and study) guided by initiation teams in each of the respective parish communities. There are four parts to the Initiation process: The Inquiry Period (runs up to the beginning of Advent), the Catechumenate (the beginning of Advent to the beginning of Lent), the Enlightenment (a more intense preparation period throughout the Lenten season), and the Mystagogia (the period after sacramental Initiation in which the new Catholic is introduced into parish community life. Additionally, there are a number of ritual celebrations connected with the Initiation process beyond the celebrations of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.

Since the Catholic experience of the Church is the local parish, the candidate seeking initiation should receive all formation and the ritual celebrations at the candidate's home parish. In the case of schedule conflicts, a candidate may choose another parish for the study and prayer formation. The ritual celebrations of Initiation (Rite of Welcoming—Beginning of Advent, Scrutiny Rites, Rite of Acceptance) as well as the Mystagogia, however, will be done at the home parish of the candidate.

It is important that the candidate discuss these matters thoroughly with the pastor and/or the parish minister of the home parish before contacting a consortium parish.

Adult Confirmation Sessions: These sessions are for adults who have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Eucharist in the Catholic faith and wish to complete their initiation with the Sacrament of Confirmation

Inquiry and Catechumenate: Sessions are held every Monday evening at 6:30 pm in the parish hall. Catechumenate sessions begin in the late Fall, which includes a second session on Sunday during the 9:45 am Mass, when Inquirers are ready to make the next commitment. A full calendar is available on request.



Marriage Preparation

Preparation for the Sacrament of Marriage is a requirement of Church law. After a couple registers their proposed wedding date with their respective parish community, they may utilize any one of the three marriage preparation programs offered within the Parish consortium. It is vital that the couple maintain communication with his or her home parish as to their choice regarding the place of preparation. Certificates will be distributed after the completion of the marriage preparation process.

St. Michael - Marriage Preparation

All sessions are held at the Activity Center located at 42850 Hayes Road (just south of 19 Mile Road). You must contact Deacon Larry Healy at 586-566-4494 to pre-register. One-on-One marriage preparation with a member of the marriage preparation team will take place if there are not enough couples to form a group.

St. Ronald - Marriage Preparation

Sessions could include a weekend stay at St. John Center, an all day Saturday at a neighboring parish, home visits with a host couple and/or meeting with our licensed Counselor staff member Rory Wagner.

Baptism Preparation

Preparation for the Sacrament of Baptism is a requirement in Church law. After a child is registered for a baptismal date, the parent(s) is required to attend an instruction class. Sponsors (Godparents) are encouraged to attend, but their attendance is not required. It is vital that the parent informs his or her home parish which preparation class will be taken. Certificates will be distributed at the completion of the preparation period.
